Commissioning of Euroa's Victoria Cross recipients statues

In 2013 Everlon Bronze was commissioned to research, design, carve, cast and supply Three full Sized Bronze Statues for the Honouring Our Hero's committee of Euroa with the delivery and unveiling of the Statues in 2015 as part of the WWI Centenary remembrance programme.

The plan includes three bronze statues with information and citations and landscaping to make the site "a place of special reverence", a unique place they believe people from around Australia would visit.

A local "honouring our heroes" committee has been formed to help plan and fund a new Victoria Cross memorial in Euroa.

While the medals can fetch up to \$1 million each at auction, the committee is struggling to find the \$350,000 for the new memorial.

"We registered with the ANZAC Centenary Commission, we have spoken to the Australian War Memorial, the RSL, and the Shrine of Remembrance all of these people think it is a great idea but they don't have sources of funds," committee spokesman Neville Harris said.

"We are just a little disappointed the government has not stepped forward and said yes . . . hopefully somebody will step forward and say they would like to support this," he said.

Mr Harris said there was strong local support for building a special place of remembrance to honour the three medallists.

Peter Burness, senior historian with the Australian War Memorial said it was "remarkable Euroa had three VC winners — possibly not repeated anywhere else in Australia".

Lieutenant (later Major) Frederick Tubb and Corporal Alexander Burton won their Victoria Crosses in the Lone Pine trenches at Gallipoli in August 1915 repelling a Turkish counter-attack — Burton was killed in the attack and awarded his medal posthumously.

Tubb died on the Western Front in France two years later.

Lieutenant Maygar won his VC rescuing a comrade under heavy fire during the Boer War in 1901 and was later killed in action during World War I.

"We think that something really good can be done to draw the attention of the whole of Australia to the sacrifices of these three men," Mr Harris said.

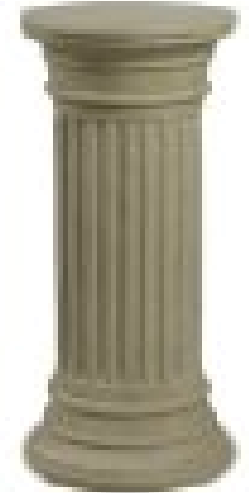

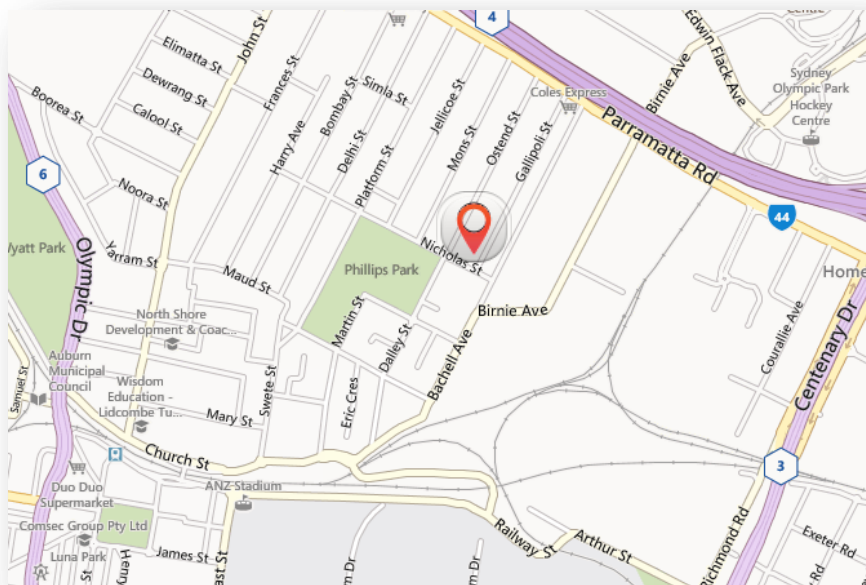
