- Assess the site's existing conditions, such as topography, soil quality, drainage, and vegetation.
- Determine the site's suitability for burial and identifying any potential design challenges or opportunities.
- Understanding additional services required.

- Engage with stakeholders and gather input on existing conditions, context, history, and demographics.

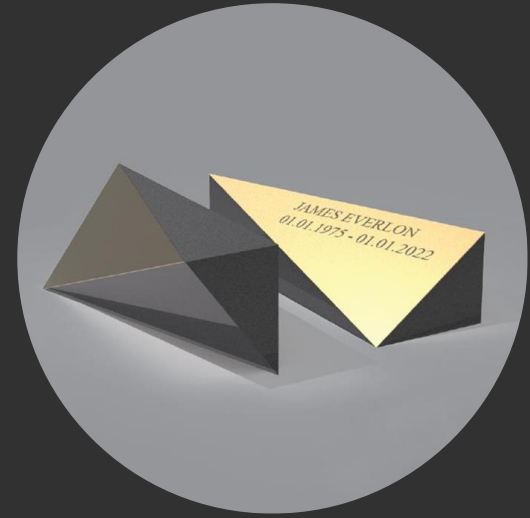
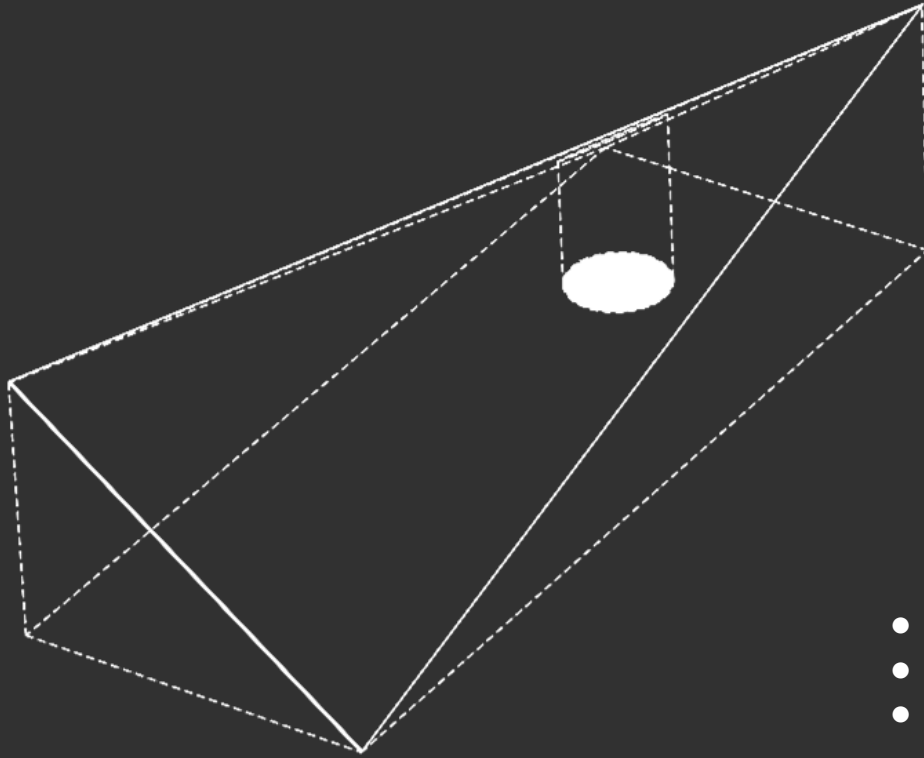
