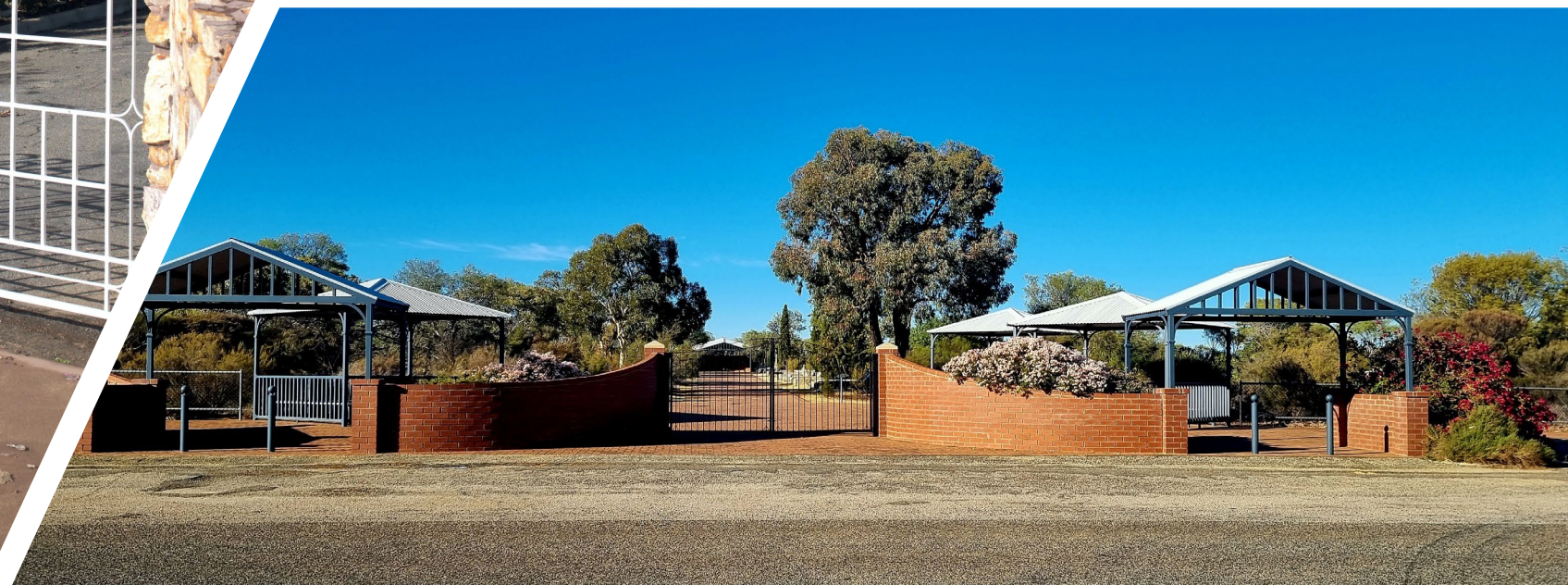

FORM OF GRANT OF RIGHT OF BURIAL.

GRANT OF RIGHT OF BURIAL
By virtue of the Cemeteries Act, 1987, the Trustees of the Moora Cemetery, in consideration of the sum of Twenty four dollars paid to them by Mrs. Mountjoy hereby grant to the said Grantee the RIGHT OF BURYING BODIES in that piece of ground Eight feet long by 12 feet 8 inches wide within the portion of the said Cemetery appropriated for the burial of adherents to the Anglican Section on the plan of the Cemetery map of the said Act.
TO HOLD the same to the said Grantee for the period of FIFTY years from the date hereof, for the purposes of burial only.
This grant is issued subject to all By-laws and Regulations, now in force, made or to be made under the above Act, or any future Act or Acts.

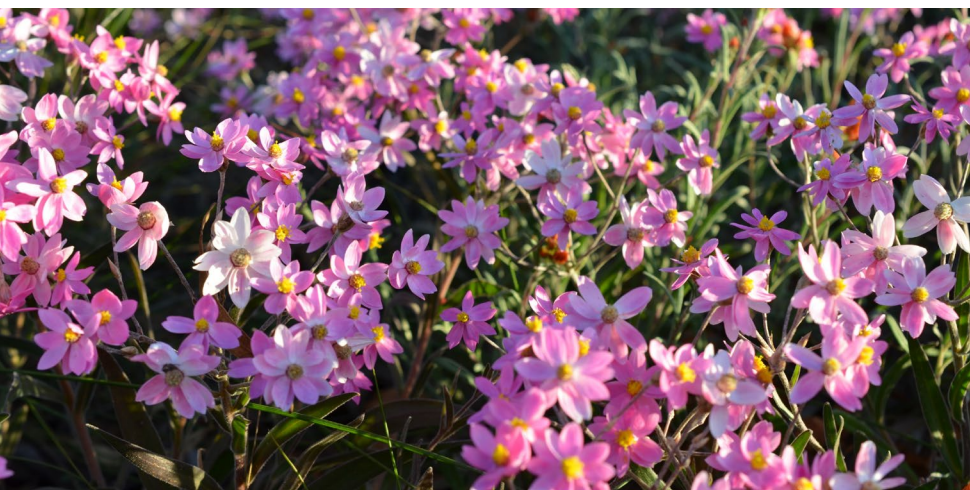
